

1. Gandhi Jayanti 2nd October 2019

To mark the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatama Gandhi, a very meaningful and solemn assembly was conducted by the students of Primary Section. It comprised of prayer service, reflection on the life of Mahatma Gandhi, poem and songs. Students from class I- V presented the meaning of Satyagraha, non-violence with the beautiful depiction on the life of Gandhiji and Lal Bahadur Shastri Ji.
