



General Circular No. 3: 2018-19

Dear Parent/Guardian

Greetings!

We have had many curricular and co-curricular activities till date, apart from the regular academic classes. We hope you have noticed the performance in your ward in the class tests and worksheets. We need your feedback and support in order to enhance and develop the holistic personality of your ward. The school authorities therefore, look forward for a positive rapport between the parents and the teachers. Now I would like to brief you with the forthcoming activities and the benchmark of the school.

1. Sports and Games: Sophian students bagged laurels in many events in CBSE tournaments, Invitational Tournaments, PIE Olympics, etc.

- **Badminton:** Energetic Sophians smashed the game held by CBSE in National Inter-School Sports Game Competition 2018-19, recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India and bagged laurels for the school. Our badminton stars Jesmi Sojan, Saloni Ambawani and Pushti Tiwari bagged Bronze Medal in the National Badminton Championship. It was held at Urmi School, Sama, Vadodara, in Under-19 Category. The event began from 21st November 2018 to 24th November 2018. They created a yardstick in the Sophian history.
- **Basket Ball:** Under the Ministry of Youth and Sports, Government of India is organizing National Level Tournament in Basket Ball. Trials were taken on 29th November, 2018 and two of our smashing students were selected for the Nationals-U-14 i.e. Manvi Srivastava and Harshita Singh to be held at Pune.
- **Wushu Competition:** Poorvi Verma of grade V won Bronze Medal for Wushu organized by Jodhpur Wushu Association, in 28 kg category.
- **Badminton (Primary Section):** Inter-House Badminton was conducted for grade IV and V on 29th November 2018. Green house bagged the 1st position

2. Skill Enhancement:-The school took initiative to begin activities in various field for grade I to XII during the zero period, such as Basket- ball, Badminton, Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Classical Dance- Kathak, Western Instrumental Music, and Indian Vocal Music from this session onwards to enhance their talent. Charges for two months for December-January is Rs.500/- each.

School Band: Students are motivated to join the school band free of cost. It will be continued till February, 2019

3. Remedial Classes: Special attention is being given to slow learners of all the grade from I to XII. Student securing less than 36% marks are made compulsory to join the remedial classes. Days are allotted for each subject.

Note: Special Coaching Classes for grade XI & XII will continue till 2:00 p.m.

4. Field trips and Outreach Programs: Students of grade V to VIII, IX and XI will be taken out for Outreach Programs, so as to imbibe in them the values of love and caring. They will visit the places such as Avedna Ashram, Galta Gate, etc.

Field Trip for Physical Education students will enhance and enrich their psycho-motor skills.

5. Periodic Test II, III and Pre Board Examination II: It will begin from 3rd January 2019 to 16th January, 2019.

- It is mandatory for all the students of grade 10 and 12 to appear in the examination.

6. PTM: The Parent Teacher Meet will be scheduled on 15th December, 2018 for Grade VI – XII.(8:00 a.m to 11:00 a.m).

Note: Students must accompany their parents in blue school uniform. The parents will go through their wards answer sheets folder in the school itself and will not carry it out of the class.

7. Winter Timings : From 3rd December,2018 onwards the school timings will be 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Parent are cautioned that the gates will be closed by 8:00 a.m. Students are expected to be in winter uniform, it includes blazer and legging(Grade I to VIII).

8. Christmas Celebration: The Christmas Celebration is scheduled for 22nd December, 2018 and thereafter begins the Winter Break.

9. School Re-Opens:- The School will reopen after the Winter Break on 2nd January, 2019.

10. Fun Games:- Students from grade K.G to XI will have fun games on 26th January,2019 and it will be clubbed with Republic Day Celebration.
