

General Circular No. 2: 2018-19

Dear Parent/Guardian

Greetings!

We have had many curricular and co-curricular activities like speech, debates declamation, symposium, extempore, storytelling, role-play, nukkad natak, dance etc. till date, apart from the regular academic classes. You have noticed the performance in your ward in the periodic tests, class tests and work sheets. The feedback during the PTA meet held in May and later in August, 2018 was applaudable. It exhibits that the parents are focused to take keen interest to follow up with the endeavors of the school. The development in your ward could only be possible through communication between the parents, the teachers and the school authorities. Now I would like to brief you with the forthcoming activities and the benchmark of the school.

1. <u>Sports & Games</u>: Students bagged laurels in many events in CBSE tournaments, SGFI tournaments and District level tournaments.

Lawn Tennis: Under 19, team participated in District level tournament held at Jai club from 6th September, 2018 to 9th September, 2018. Silver Medal and Bronze Medal was bagged in the Individual Events. Bronze Medal bagged in Team Event.

The teams participated for State Level Competition in Kota. The team won all the events and bagged Gold Medal Sneha Gehlot (IX-D) is selected for participating in National Camp in December. Kudos to our winners.

Badminton: Under 19 team participated in District Level Badminton Tournament. The team won Gold Medal in Team Event and Individual Event and also selected for National camp.

Athletics: Nandini Sharma declared **Best Athlete** in CBSE West Zone Tournament as she won Gold Medal in 200 and 400 m race.

Boxing: Kanishka Naruka won Gold Medal in boxing conducted by District Boxing Association and Bronze Medal in CBSE West Zone Boxing Championship.

Primary Section:

- **Interhouse Basket Ball competition** was held in July 2018 and Red house won the match.
- Interhouse March past competition will be held in the month of November, 2018.
- 2. NCC: The NCC cadets participated in Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) on 28th September 2018 to 7th October, 2018 at the VIT campus Jagatpura. Students along with their caretaker Mrs. Anshul Saxena participated and bagged Gold Medal in all the competitions beginning with Parade. They bagged Gold Medal in dance competition, Silver Medal in Rifle Shooting, Gold Medal for Best Anchoring, Silver Medal for Quiz Competition, Gold Medal for Extempore, Silver Medal in Nukkad -Natak. Kritika Singh from thal Sainik Camp bagged Gold Medal.
- 3. <u>Skill Enhancement</u>:-The school took initiative to begin activities in various field for grade I to XII during the zero period, such as Basket- ball, Badminton Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Classical Dance- Kathak, Western Instrumental Music, and Indian Vocal Music from this session onwards to enhance their talent. Charges for two months for each is Rs.700/- School Band: Students are motivated to join the school band free of cost.

- 4. <u>Remedial Classes</u>: Special attention is being given to slow learners of all the grade from I to XII. Student securing less than 36% marks are made compulsory to join the remedial classes. Days are allotted for each subject.
 - Note: Special Coaching Classes for grade XI & XII will begin from 29th October, 2018 till 1.30 p.m.
- **5.** <u>Field trips:</u> Students of grade VI, VII, VIII visited Nahargarh Biological Park. Students of grade XI and XII visited institutions related to biotechnology, jewellery and fashion designing, culinary and food technology and national heritage.
- **6. School Picnic**: School Picnics are organised for the students for their recreation and to have quality time. Picnics are arranged for the following classes on following dates;
 - IX X 16^{th} November,2018, VI VIII 17^{th} November,2018, I -V 20^{th} November 2018, XII 22^{nd} November,2018
- 7. Periodic Test 3 and Pre Board Examination I: It will begin from 26th November 2018 to 8th December, 2018.
 - It is mandatory for all the students of grade 10 and 12 to appear in the examination.
- **8.** Retirement: Sophian fraternity will bid adieu to Mrs. Stella Peter on 31st October, 2018. The school will be celebrating her committed and dedicated service to this institution.
- **9.** <u>PTM</u>: The Parent Teacher Meet and the distribution of report cards of Periodical Test II/ Half yearly will be as per the schedule given below:
