Greetings!

We believe in fostering a child, developing his mind and nurturing his soul. Sophia lay stress on moral values, love and concern for our surroundings and this approach of encouragement to the students allows them and grow up as independent, confident, perfect and honest human beings. The development in your ward could only be possible through communication between the parents, the teachers and the school authorities. Now I would like to brief you with the forthcoming activities and the benchmark of the school:-

- 1. <u>New Incharges</u>:-Sr. Joselyn-KG Incharge, Sr. Cynthia David-Vice Principal and Sr. Aruna Peter-Primary Incharge joined the school management w.e.f from July 01, 2019 respectively. We welcome the sisters of varied wings and also welcome all the new appointees to Sophian Family.
- 2. <u>Annual Prize Distribution:-</u>For the splendid academic excellence in the year 2018-19, the Annual Prize Distribution was held for the students of grade LKG to grade XII. The high achievers of the last academic year were awarded.
- 3. <u>Sports: Manvi Srivastava of our school with her outstanding performance in Youth National Basketball Championship held at Coimbatore got Rajasthan Team to win Bronze Medal by defeating the Punjab Team. It's an historical achievement as Rajasthan Girls Basketball team has bagged a medal for the first time ever. The Sports Minister of Rajasthan along with the various sports Associations felicitated the team members.</u>
  - Our school Basket Ball team participated in "Khel Mahakumbh" held at Choughan Stadium from 24<sup>th</sup> June to 26<sup>th</sup> June, where the junior team U-14 stood as Runner up, whereas, the senior team U-17 emerged out as winners.
  - Rainbow Sports Academy organized the Basket Ball Tournament from 28<sup>th</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, the Sophian team bagged the Championship in U-14 and U-17 bagged the Runner up trophy.
  - School Basket Ball team also participated in Edmunds Cup from 10<sup>th</sup> July to 13<sup>th</sup> July 2019, they stood Runner up.

**Boxing**:-Sophian Boxer Kanishka Naruka (IX) bagged Gold Medal in District Level Boxing Championship, Gold Medal at Khel Mahakumbh at Choughan Stadium and Bronze Medal at State Level Boxing Championships (52 to 54 kg category).

**Taekwondo:** - Bronze Medal was bagged by Rachael S. Mathew, Gauri Mathur, Saniya Parveen and Avika Tiwari at 29<sup>th</sup> District Sub - Junior Taekwondo Championship, 2019.

**Korf Ball and Net Ball : -** Seven students are selected for the National Net Ball Tournament and two students for the National Korf Ball Tournament.

**Games: -** In Primary, Interhouse Sports Competition were held to enhance their psycho - motor skills. Topaz House bagged 1st position in Kho-Kho, Lawn Tennis and Badminton. Emerald house bagged 1st position in Basket Ball.

- 4. NCC: For the first time in Sophia in grade XI, Kritika Singh is selected for NCC senior wing .Cadet Kritika Singh bagged Gold Medal in the Shooting and Anchoring Competition. She received a cheque of Rs. 4500/as a scholarship and was honoured as the Best Cadet. The cadet also bagged second position in drill, ballet, flag area. Enrolment for NCC 1919-20 is completed and 50 students are selected from VIII and IX.
- 5. <u>Catechism Diocese Exam:</u>-Our 31 students bagged prizes in all the three category First, Second and Third. Students proved that apart from academic excellence, they excelled in their spiritual assessment.

## 6. Primary Achievement:-

• Talented Artist Krishnapriya R. Dharamveer (Grade V) participated in a National Art Exhibition in the Pink City Green Art Show held at Jawahar Kala Kendra from the 22<sup>nd</sup> June to 24<sup>th</sup> June. She was awarded the Best Participant Award for her creative and innovative art -piece by Padma Shree Tilak Gitai.

- Disha Chattopadhya (Grade V) the Sophian Nightiangle presented her melodious voice at All India Radio. She was appreciated and was awarded a cash prize of Rs.500/-
- Pinky Prasad (Grade V) bagged second position in Drawing Competition by Konark Academy on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, on account of World Environment Day.
- 7. Skill Enhancement:-The school took initiative to begin activities in various field for grade I to XII during the zero period, such as Basket-ball, Badminton Lawn Tennis, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Skating Classical Dance- Kathak, Western Instrumental Music, and Indian Vocal Music from this session onwards to enhance their talent and the charges till March 2020 will be Rs 2000/-.
  - **School Band:** Students are motivated to join the school band free of cost.
- 8. <u>Field trips and Outreach Programs:</u> Students of grade I to IX and XI will be taken out for Outreach Programs, so as to imbibe in them the values of love and caring. Field Trip for Physical Education students will enhance and enrich their psycho-motor skills. Industrial Visit enhances entrepreneurship skills and creativity.
- 9. **Remedial Classes**: Special attention is being given to slow learners of all the grade from **I to XII**. **Student securing less than 36% marks are made compulsory to join the remedial classes.** Days are allotted for each subject.
- 10. <u>Additional Coaching:-</u>Students of Grade XII of Science stream will be given extra coaching with regard to the preparation of competitive exams such as NEET and JEE to be schedule in 2020.

Note: - Interested students have to stay back on 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of every month from 12 noon to 1 p.m. and so kindly make the arrangements.

## 11. Worksheets:-

- For grade IX to XII, students will get worksheets in all the subject based on Objective Type Questions as Online Assignment, every month on 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday for X and XII and on 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday for IX and XI. The students are to submit the answer sheets on 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday for class X and XII and 4<sup>th</sup> Friday for IX and XI, failing which there would be minus marking affecting their results.
- For Grade I to XII, students will get worksheets based on the Subjective Type Questions as Class Test to enhance their knowledge and learning skills from 18<sup>th</sup> September to 20<sup>th</sup> September.
