- 1. Sports and Games:** Sophian champs bagged laurels in JECRC Tournament, CBSE Clusters XIV, Maharaja Sawai Bhawani Singh Cup, CBSE Nationals, PIE Olympics, etc.
 - **Basket-Ball:** - The spirited and vigorous team participated in JECRC University Tournament and stood Runners Up.
 - CBSE Clusters XIV held at Bliss International School, Tonk and our team emerged as *Winners* by defeating St. Edmunds, Jawahar Nagar, Fateh Public School, NPS School, St. Mary and MGPS. Our team qualified to represent team Rajasthan in CBSE Nationals.
 - Maharaja Sawai Bhawani Singh Cup was conducted and our champs mushroomed as *Winners* defeating the host school.
 - In CBSE Nationals held at St. Teresa School, Mansarover, our champs defeated Oman, Aligarh and Kerala and Jhalandhar to top the pool. The Sophian team was able to make their place in the First 8 teams in India. Kudos to our champs!!
 - **Badminton:** - The energetic and smashing team of Sophia participated in PIE Olympics, conducted by Patrika Group held at SMS Stadium .Our school bagged 2nd Position in U-14 and 3rd Position in U-18 Category.
 - **Taekwondo:** - Our students participated in Open State Taekwondo Championship, 2019, at Rajasthan University. Purvi Verma bagged Gold Medal and *Kicking Pad* as gift, Khushi Choudhary and Avika Tiwari bagged Silver Medal and Lakshita Mishra bagged Bronze Medal. In CBSE National Taekwondo Championship, 2019 at Balrampur, U.P, Gauri Mathur participated and showed her varied punches. Our students are selected for the Nationals. Kudos to all!!
- 2. NCC (Army wing):**-Our cadets participated in NCC Day Celebration at Maharaja College, Jaipur and represented National Integration through a mesmerizing dance performance.

3. Achievements:-

- **Primary**-Eduvision organized Inter-School Abacus Competition at St. Anselm's Pink City School, Malviya Nagar, Jaipur, wherein, 549 students from varied schools participated out of which, 17 Sophian Brain -Teasers won trophy at varied levels.
- **Secondary**:-Vikram Sarabhai Centenary Programme 2019-20 was organized by ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) Department of Space, Government of India, held at Birla Institute of Scientific Research, Jaipur. Our students participated in varied events with great zeal and enthusiasm. Akshita Saxena X-C bagged First Position in Quiz and Venya Gangwani XI-D secured Third Position in Elocution Competition.

4. Remedial Classes: Special attention is being given to slow learners of all the grade from I to XII. Student securing less than 36% marks are made compulsory to join the remedial classes. Days are allotted for each subject.

5. Outreach Programs: Students of grade VI to VIII, IX and XI will be taken out for Outreach Programs, so as to imbibe in them the values of love and caring. They will visit the places such as Avedna Ashram, Mother Teresa, Pratap Nagar, Poddar Deaf School, Kanakheri HIV Aids Center, etc.

6. Periodic Test II, III and Pre Board Examination: Pre-Board Examination will begin from 3rd December 2019 to 19th December, 2019. PA II and PA III will begin from 7th December, 2019 to 14th December, 2019. **It is mandatory for all the students of grade 10 and 12 to appear in the examination.**

7. PTM: The Parent Teacher Meet will be scheduled on 15th January, 2020, for grade VI – XII (8:00 a.m to 11:00 a.m).

Note: Students must accompany their parents in blue school uniform. The parents will go through their wards answer sheets folder in the school itself and will not carry it out of the class.

8. Christmas Celebration: The Christmas celebration is scheduled for 21st December, 2019 and thereafter begins the Winter Break.


9. School Re-Opens:- The school will reopen after the Winter Break on 6th January, 2020.
