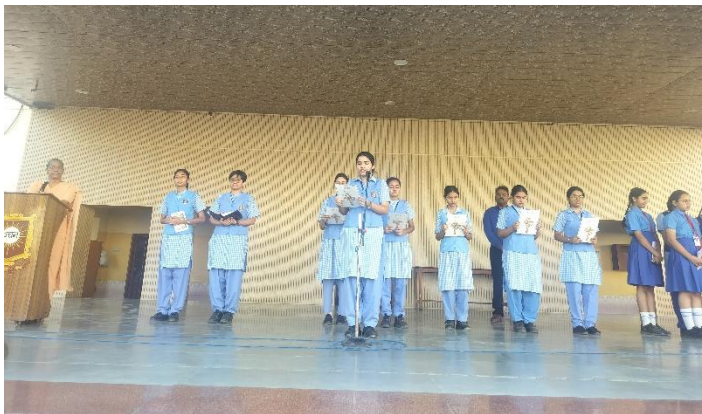

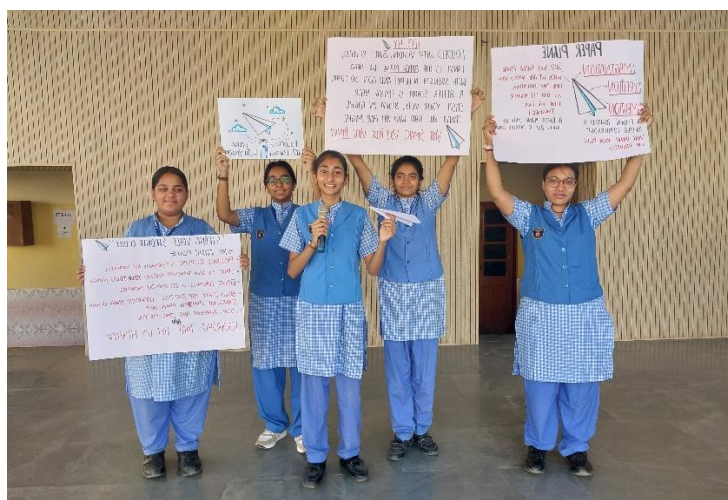






## Election Campaigning
